


I have caught myself attempting to call my dad on the cellphone several times over the past three months because we talked so often. But one thing I have been totally immersed in during these days after the funeral is that I can still talk to my Father. My dad may be gone from my presence, but

The GBA Missions Team is tasked with reviewing, approving, rejecting, or amending applications submitted based on the following criteria:

- 1. GBA must receive a written Request Form.
- 2. An approved contact person from the church requesting the funds must be on file for each mission project request, with necessary contact information.
- 3. Since this is a matching program (\$500 maximum); the church must have an equal or greater financial commitment than the request.
- 4. Church leadership must submit a written report of the event results and any pertinent comments concerning the supported mission activity, within two weeks after the event.

 5. Mission project funding will only be offered to actively supporting churches.

 6. The financial commitment is for the current year only.
